PROCESSING PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASIS	<p>Widok.gov.pl is an analytical portal of public administration. It is not only the statistics of public administration e-services, but also the target tool for shaping the development strategy of digital administration. This is an activity that implements the idea of transparency of administration and citizen's involvement in shaping the directions of development of e-services. The data of widok.gov.pl system are subject to constant analysis and use by the administration, entrepreneurs and citizens.</p> <p>The legal basis is work commissioned by the Ministry of Digitization.</p>
DATA RECIPIENTS	Widok.gov.pl system is available as a web-enabled application access to data for citizens, entrepreneurs and social organization following the activities of the Minister of Digitization at: https://widok.gov.pl/ .
DATA STORAGE TERM	Your personal data will be processed for 10 years term from introduction into widok.gov.pl system.
DATA SUBJECTS RIGHTS	You have the right to access your data, demand their rectification, erasure or limitation of their processing.
RIGHT TO LODGE A COMPLAINT TO THE SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY	You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority dealing with the protection of personal data in the Member State of your residence, place of employment or place of the alleged infringement.
INFORMATION ABOUT THE PROVIDE DATA OBLIGATION	Providing personal data by obliged entities is obligatory because it results from the legal basis indicated above.
